



## CAMP SE KONSA!

### ***How many special needs children are in your area?***

There are at least 75 children that we know of and we have not yet contacted the school for deaf and blind children.

### ***Is the camp strictly for children with special needs?***

No, the camp is for the family and siblings to come. We are also opening it up to those wanting to rent the camp for retreats or conferences.

### ***How many children will it accommodate at one time?***

Twenty-five children and a parent, and 25 volunteers

### ***The ratio of children to volunteers?***

Is 1 to 1

### ***Will the Word of God be shared with the families and children that come?***

We will be having worship each evening, and a Bible story during the day.

### ***What are the current financial needs of the camp?***

Our current project is the shower/bathhouse and the projected cost is \$15,000 to complete it.

### ***What are the current financial needs of the ministry?***

We need monthly support for living expenses and Levi has a medical need of about \$1,000 a month for growth hormone shots. He is 10 and is just now up to 50 lbs and about the height of a seven year old.

### ***Will there be medical staff at the camp?***

Yes, there will be a nurse full time on staff while the camp is in session. We will also have a therapist to give parents some ideas on how to help their children when they leave, and a counselor for parents and children to discuss the joys and struggles they have.

***How many days or nights will the camp be?***

We will have 2 kinds of camps – a weekend camp for the whole family and then a 4 day, 3 night camp for a parent and special needs child.

***Will the camp be year-round?***

Our intensions are to be able to have 4 to 6 camps a year. There will also be events throughout the year, such as the event in August and Christmas Dec. 7, which are day events.

***Is there a charge for the children?***

They will pay \$12.50 to register, then we will give them a paper to have people sponsor them for the last \$100. We will run fundraisers and also try to get sponsors so that every child that wants to come can.

***Do you provide transportation?***

Yes, and we will raise funds to purchase a wheelchair accessible van. Some of the children will be in small villages and can't even get to a bus station. We will have a camp for each district in Belize, planning to reach all of Belize. When we do a district at a time, the friends and families they meet at the camp are also their neighbors, therefore continuing to build relationships between the families.

***Where is food coming from?***

Most of the food provided will be from the camp itself. We already have chickens and sheep. There is a plan for a greenhouse to provide vegetables. The plans are for the camp to be self-sufficient for overnight camping within 5 years of opening.

***Is there staff during the camp and where are they coming from?***

There will be cooks and cleaners that will be local and paid help as well as teams that have volunteered for that week's camp.
